Prospective contractors are hereby notified that the San Bernardino International Airport Authority (SBIAA) will receive one (1) original sealed bid proposal and two (2) copies for the Oscillating Monitor Nozzle Project. Such proposals will be received at the Airport Administration Office, Attention Clerk of the Board, 294 S. Leland Norton Way, Suite 1, San Bernardino, California, 92408, until **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 2, 2008**, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read. In bold lettering, the bid proposals shall be marked with the following words: “**OSCILLATING MONITOR NOZZLE PROJECT.**” Parties are required to check the SBIAA website, at www.sbdairport.com under “RFP/Bids,” for any supplemental information which may be posted for the benefit of preparation of Bid packages.

A **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting for prospective bidders and their sub-contractors will be held at 294 S. Leland Norton Way, Suite 1, San Bernardino, California, at **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 20, 2008.**

The scope of work for the Oscillating Monitor Nozzle Project includes, but is not limited to: furnish and install six (6) each Oscillating Monitor Nozzles of identical model number and manufacturer, install all necessary piping, mounting stands, fittings, brackets, flanges and hardware. This project shall also include a five (5) year certification for the Oscillating Monitor Nozzle system.
