Q1. Should the "Potential Deductive Bid Items" be considered as a "negative" or a "positive" cost?

A1. *Potential Deductive Bid Items for KST Yard and Building 759 have been deleted from the Project. Please refer to Addendum No. 2 and revised BD-24-Summary page.*

Q2. Who is responsible for the construction staking/survey on the job?

A2. *The Contractor is responsible for providing their own construction staking and surveying as stated in "Special Requirements - General Provisions" Section 28 Surveying (Page SR-GP-10).*

Q3. Who is responsible for the unclassified excavation material?

A3. *Unclassified excavation material is the Contractor's responsibility. Please refer to "Special Requirements - General Provisions" Section 24 On-site Materials Disposal (Page SR-GP-9).*

Q4. Bid Item 701: how do we consider the allowance for the "removal of contaminated soil"?

A4. *The \$25,000 allowance will cover for eventual observation by AECOM (hazmat consultant) and for the disposal of contaminated soil by Contractor.*

Q5. Who will contact and control AECOM'S hours?

A5. *IVDA's Project Construction Management Team*

Q6. Does an NOI need to be filed? If so, who is responsible for filing.

A6. *Yes an NOI needs to be filed by the Contractor. Please refer to Bid Schedule 100 Specifications - Bid Item 105 NPDES Compliance (Page SR-100-2).*

Q7. Is construction fencing required around the entire site?

A7. *Temporary fencing has been considered only around Contractor's yard.*

Q8. In Appendix 4, what are the Affirmative Action requirements? What is considered "minority"? Are the requirements for the construction work or for the Contractor's employment workforce?

A8. *The Affirmative Action requirements are for minority and female participation. Minorities are classified as American Indian and Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, Hispanic or Latino, and people of two or more races. The participation requirements as stated in Appendix 4 may be a combination of the Contractor's work force including subcontractors for the construction work performed in the the covered area.
