**SO CAL PRECISION AIRCRAFT, INC. Announces Significant Increase in
Employment at San Bernardino International Airport**

**SO CAL PRECISION AIRCRAFT INC. Announces the Establishment of an Engine
Repair and Overhaul Facility at the San Bernardino International Airport**

The San Bernardino International Airport (SBD) is pleased to announce a significant increase in employment and aircraft maintenance activities at the Airport. The activity is a direct result of infrastructure improvements made over the last several years including substantial hangar, utility and roadway upgrades.

San Bernardino based So Cal Precision Aircraft Inc. ("So Cal") has announced the establishment of a new subsidiary at the Airport that, upon its certification by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), will repair and overhaul commercial jet engines. The Jet Engine Repair and Overhaul Facility will be located in the additional space that So Cal is leasing from SBD Aircraft Services, LLC in the Airport's Central Hangar Complex. SBD Aircraft Services, LLC holds the Master Lease on the Central Hangar Complex and coordinated So Cal's expansion with the Airport Staff.

"The establishment of the Jet Engine Repair and Overhaul Facility continues our strategy of making the Airport attractive by offering potential users a complete array of aircraft support services in one location" said Loma Linda Mayor Robert H. Christman, Vice President of the Airport Commission.

Currently, So Cal is performing Aircraft Maintenance on six aircraft at the Airport with an additional three aircraft expected to arrive in the next two weeks. In order to accommodate the arrival of the additional aircraft, So Cal has begun the recruitment of employees to provide the necessary support for the increased activities. As of May 1, 2007, So Cal will employ 177 jobs in its facility at the Central Hangar Complex.

This represents over 400% increase in employment since So Cal began its initial operations at the Airport in September 2006. “It is exciting to see the Airport and all of the surrounding communities benefiting from our preparatory work including the infrastructure and facility upgrades in the last few years” said San Bernardino County 3rd District Supervisor and Airport Authority Commissioner, Dennis Hansberger.

Greg Albert, President of So Cal said “The growth and success of our operations in San Bernardino have exceeded our most optimistic projections. The increase in aircraft maintenance activity and the establishment of the Jet Engine Repair Facility would not have been possible without the significant infrastructure improvements recently made to the Central Hangar Complex”

“The Airport is becoming the engine for economic and employment growth that we knew it could be for San Bernardino and the surrounding communities. At the same time, the Airport Authority is developing the infrastructure and support services we will need in the future. It's an exciting time at SBD,” said San Bernardino Mayor Patrick J. Morris, President of the Airport Authority Commission.
